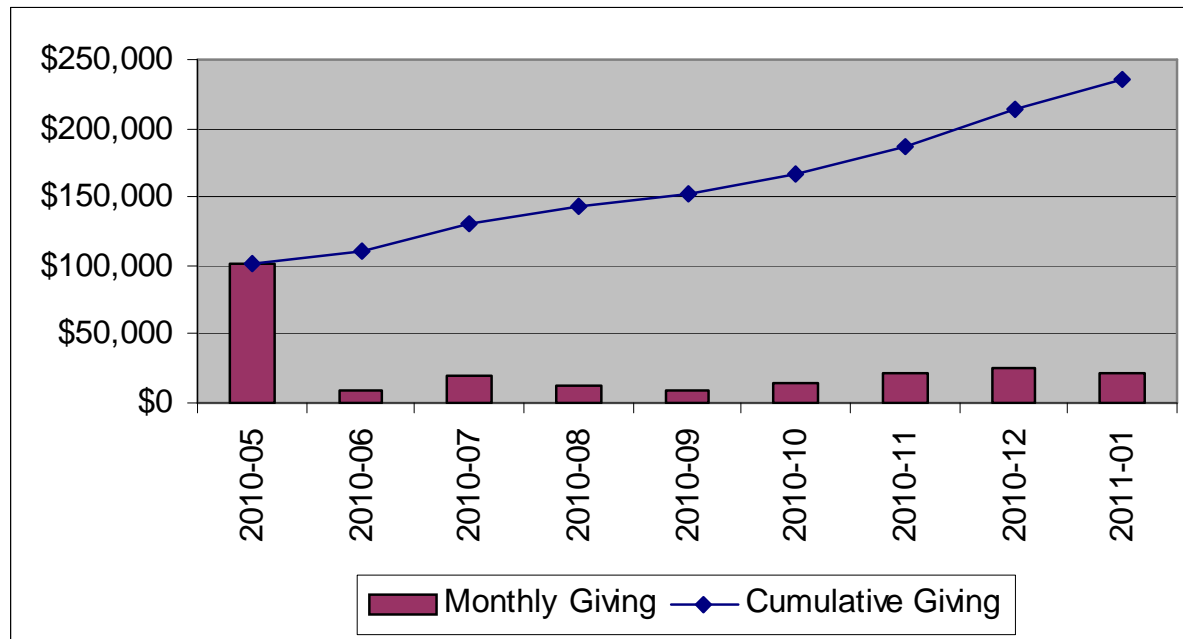

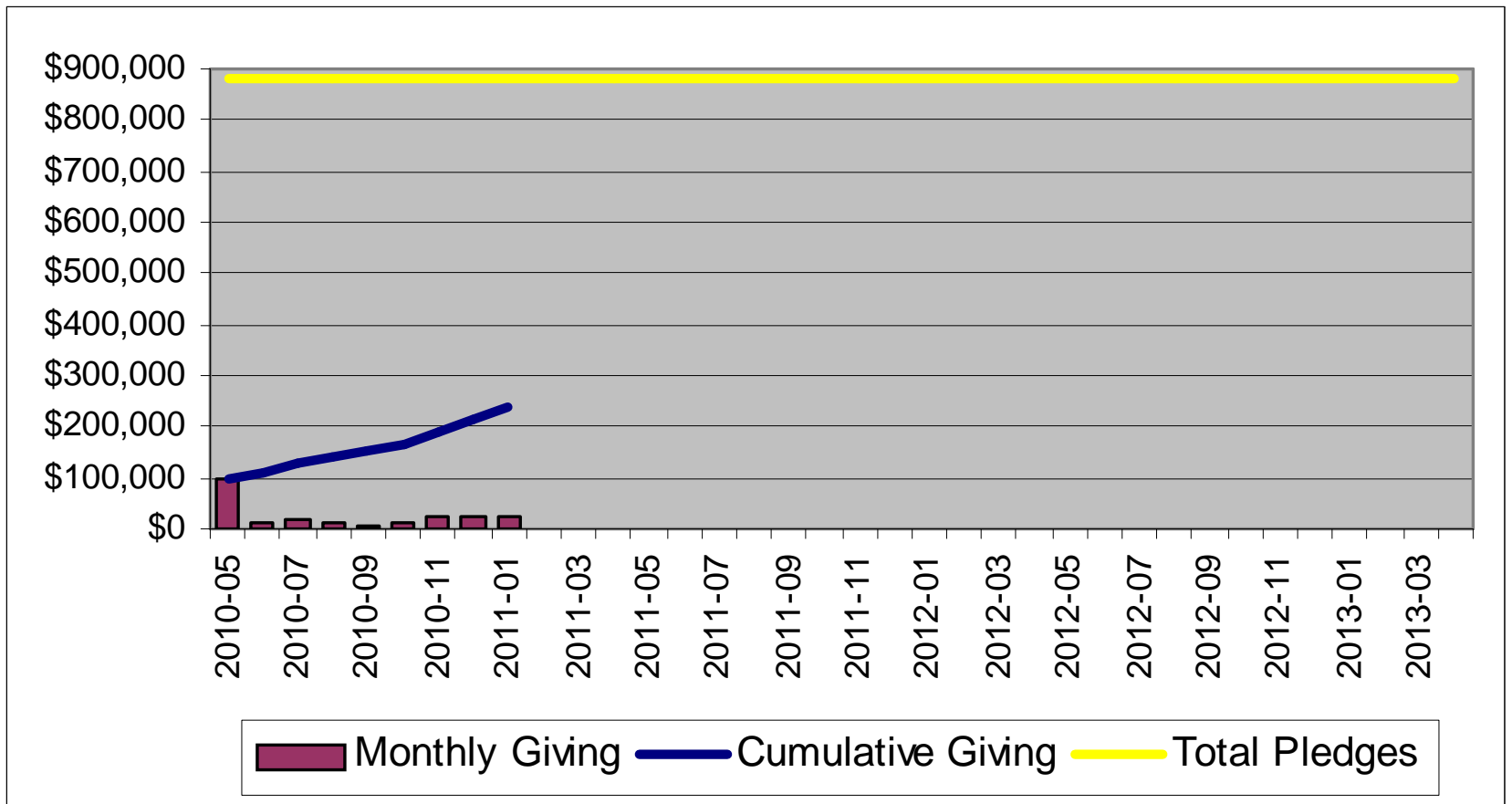
Trust BIG Update
